Update on CCA's activities - Ukraine

Corps Consulaire Aarhus, in co-operation with the Ukrainien Embassy and Consulate are privileged and proud beeing entrusted donations for on-forwarding to the Ukrainien citizens at a terrible and most difficult time.

We have over the past few days delivered 4 trailer loads, 130 Pallets of new warm clothing donated by Bestseller A/S, via the Ukraine Ministry of Health (MOH), reaching out to patients and families, employees at hospitals and health centers.

From Bestseller and other donors, we have today received more clothing - for children only, we shall immediately dispatch 2xcomplete truckloads with our logistic partners DFDS A/S, cargo to be forwarded to MOH distribution center at Lliv, from where on-forwarding to the national hospitals and health clinics takes place. - logistics & transportation being sponsored by J. Lauritzen Foundation, UHI (Hamburg) Rotary Club in Aarhus and Momenta ApS.

We further this week dispatch a complete load of hospital equipment, a.o. beds, various furniture and wheelchairs for MOH, donations made possible by our member, Honorary Consular Marianne Bols (Georgia) who have the contact to HUMANI from where the donations originate. - The approach from our members of CCA offering assistance, is a joy and motivation driver helping us, together trying to make a difference. - having said that, this week also meant that The Aarhus City Council has donated further hospital & nursing furniture, along with a large portion of "self-test" COVID equipment. - At the specific request of the Ukrainien Ambassador Mr Vydoynyk Mykhailo and our fellow member, Morten Munk, we shall with priority seek to supply Hostmel Municipality, which currently are suffering terribly!
